

Seminar Lead: Rev. Dr. Jack Custer



Fr Jack Custer has had a long ministry in pastoring inner city and suburban parishes, serving as dean and professor in two seminaries, and has preached and lectured in parishes around the USA. He earned a licentiate from the Pontifical Biblical Institute and a doctorate from the Pontifical Gregorian University. He focuses on the interplay among biblical exegesis, homiletics, and hymnography in the Byzantine Tradition. He has published 4 books on the Old and New Testaments, several volumes of biblical meditations and, most recently, an exhaustive commentary on the Akathistos Hymn to the Theotokos.
